- There has been considerable progress throughout all grade levels
- Utilizing grant monies to implement a tutorial services to assist students who have shown a need for support
- Continuing to compare data with similar schools and partnerships within the district. Mr. Daniels will send out preliminary analysis of progress to Board members

## • Hybrid ReEntry Plan reported

- Deep cleaning performed every Wednesday and Friday
- High Touch Cleaning performed regularly throughout the day
- Student schedules for in-person instruction are staggered to follow CDC guidelines
- o 60% of students have chosen to remain virtual
- Vaccination data reported
  - 20% of staff already vaccinated, 20% have already registered but not yet received vaccination
  - Staff Professional Development will be focused on vaccination awareness- a pediatrician will come in and answer questions for staff and families

- Middle States Accreditation Report presented
  - Surveys have been distributed to staff, students and parent/guardians to gauge satisfaction with school.
  - o On track for completing Self-study year
